

Parliament: Government Not Bulldozing Bills

KUALA LUMPUR, April 19 (Bernama) -- Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Liew Vui Keong Thursday refuted claims by opposition MPs that the government planned to bulldoze eight bills by arranging them to be tabled in today's Dewan Rakyat sitting.

Today is also the last day of the Dewan Rakyat sitting for this session.

"No, no, there is no such thing as bulldozing. All the MPs have been given notice (on April 16) on all these bills in the Order Paper. How can they be bulldozed.

"They cannot say they did not know about it, we have already given them notice earlier," he told reporters when met at Parliament's lobby.

He was asked to respond to complaints by opposition MPs that there will not be enough time to debate all the eight bills at the policy and committee levels today.
