

Taib Wants People To Carry On Enjoying Government Development

KUCHING, May 1 (Bernama) -- Chief Minister Tan Sri Abdul Taib Mahmud expressed his wish to see the people of Sarawak carry on enjoying the benefits of government development.

Taib added that the government has not only provided facilities for the people but also taken steps to raise the level of education and skills among the younger generations.

"I'm like a midwife who helps a mother deliver her child, but the child needs to be raised by the mother," he said during a speech at the launch of Pesaka Bumiputera Bersatu party's youth movement programme at the Kuching Waterfront today.

He noted that the Sarawak Corridor of Renewable Energy (SCORE), which provides employment opportunities for the younger generations, was one example of the many programmes undertaken by the government.

According to Taib, SCORE with its RM3 billion investment in various industries, is expected to provide about a quarter of a million jobs in the next 20 years.
