

**Take Legal Action Against Saturday's Rally Organisers, Says Rais

KUALA LUMPUR, May 1 (Bernama) -- Information, Communications and Culture Minister Datuk Seri Dr Rais Yatim said legal action should be taken against Bersih co-chairman Datuk Ambiga Sreenevasan and opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim and their supporters for causing the public rally in the federal capital to turn violent on Saturday.

He said they had breached the Peaceful Assembly Act 2012, besides going against the court injunction which prevented the rally participants from entering Dataran Merdeka.

"I believe the DPP is ready to take them to court," he said at his office, here, Monday.

The gathering was supposed to demand for electoral reform but and ended in violence when the demonstrators refused to disperse, became unruly and broke the barricade set up around Dataran Merdeka.

Besides damaging public property, the demonstrators also attacked and overturned police patrol cars. Rais said photographs taken of the rioting clearly proved that the protest rally was not clean, but dirty and violent.
