

Activist Detained For Affixing Bersih 3.0 Poster In USM

GEORGE TOWN, April 20 (Bernama) -- A man was arrested while he was putting up Bersih 3.0 posters in the Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM) campus, early this morning.

A police source said a campus security guard had detained Tan Hong Kai, 21, who was busy putting up posters on the assembly within lecture hall premises at 2.30am.

He said Tan, a Suara Rakyat Malaysia (Suaram) activist, was sent to the Sungai Nibong police station for further investigation.

Meanwhile, Timur Luat police chief ACP Gan Kong Meng, when contacted, said Tan was released on police bail after his statement was taken.

"Investigation on the case will be continued and an investigation will be referred to the Penang Deputy Public Prosecutor for further orders," he said.
