

**Sabah Flourishing Under Musa's Leadership: Muhyiddin

RANAU, April 27 (Bernama) -- Sabah has enjoyed flourishing development under the leadership of Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman.

Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin expressed his amazement saying Sabah, which he considers as his second home, is the second state visited following the prosperity and achievements made.
