

**NFCorp Chief Meets Bank Negara Officials**

KUALA LUMPUR, April 30 (Bernama) -- National Feedlot Corporation (NFCorp) chairman Datuk Dr Mohamad Salleh Ismail Monday met with Bank Negara Malaysia officials to provide details of alleged breaches of financial rules involving Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) strategy director Mohd Rafizi Ramli.

He reiterated his claim that the PKR official had distributed to the media private and confidential banking details and credit ratings of NFCorp and its related companies, as well as the personal bank details of the directors and shareholders of the companies, without the consent of the companies and directors.

Twenty-one counts of alleged violations by Rafizi and breaches by a local bank were lodged with Bank Negara, according to a statement from NFCorp.

He lodged a police report on the purported violations under the Banking and Financial Institutions Act (Bafia) on April 26.

Mohamad Salleh urged the police and Bank Negara to investigate the alleged Bafia contraventions.
