

**Opposition MPs Involved In Rally Show No Respect For Law, Says Ahmad Zahid

KUALA LUMPUR, May 3 (Bernama) -- The opposition-backed demonstration around Dataran Merdeka here which turned violent last Saturday shows that the opposition members of parliament involved have no respect for the law which they themselves supported in parliament.

Defence Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi who said this, noted that they (opposition) also did not respect the court's decision.

The Kuala Lumpur Magistrate's Court had issued an injunction preventing any gathering to be held at Dataran Merdeka from April 28 to May 1.

"The gathering which was supposed to be peaceful to demand for fair and clean elections instead degenerated into chaos and violence, causing damage to public property," he said in his speech at the ministry's staff monthly assembly, here, Thursday.

Ahmad Zahid said the rally organisers' demand were already addressed by the government with the formation of the Parliamentary Select Committee for Electoral Reform, which also included opposition MPs.
