

**Sabah Information Department To Set Up Election Media Centre**

KOTA KINABALU, May 3 (Bernama) -- The Ministry of Information Communication and Culture (KPKK), through the Sabah Information Department, will set up a media centre for the 13th general election that will begin operations as soon as Parliament is dissolved.

Sabah Information Director Almain Ajirul said the election media centre would be opened at the Kompleks Bersepadu, KPKK to carry out media relations and management functions as well as to provide facilities to mass media personnel who would be covering the general election.

"The centre will be opened at the Kompleks Bersepadu, KPKK as the complex is more comfortable and convenient for the journalists to visit during the general election which is expected to be held this year," he said at a media conference, here Thursday.

He said the media centre would help the media personnel to obtain information throughout the general election.

The federal government has been given the mandate up to April 27, 2013 to hold the general election. Sarawak had its state election in April last year.
