

**Not Only Political Power On The Line In 13th GE, But Also Nation's Fate –
Muhyiddin

KUALA LUMPUR, May 11 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin reminded Umno members that the coming 13th general election (GE) would not only put political power on the line, but also the struggle and fate of the nation.

As such, he urged Umno members to get ready and be prepared for the GE election, which would be held soon, as it would be the mother of all elections that would determine the continuity of Umno's struggle.

"We have to prepare a lineup of Umno fighters who really work hard and are capable of winning the people's hearts. This is the moment and time Umno will face its most dreadful test," he said at Umno's 66th anniversary celebration at the Bukit Jalil National Stadium here Friday night.

Muhyiddin also warned the enemies of Umno not to upset the unity and harmony that had been built and not to spread information and ideologies that could affect the people's faith.

"Don't allow them to damage our way of life which is ethical and moral. Do not, in any way, consent and allow the people to be polluted with deviationist teachings and ideologies," he added.

He said Umno should remain as the frontline for the people and the people's champion, adding that if destroyed, it could damage the unity and harmony that had been built.

Muhyiddin also called on Umno members to get ready for the battle to ensure victory for the party in the GE.

"Mr President, we are ready to move. You have our allegiance. We have pledged our determination and commitment. Sound the battle cry.

"There is nothing more meaningful to the party other than victory in the coming election," he added.

Wishing the more than 100,000 Umno members present at the venue a happy 66th anniversary, he said he hoped the gathering was proof that its members were the generation which would continue with the true Umno struggle.

"Let us make this gathering a battlefield for us to strengthen our confidence, determination, hope and with humility, celebrate our success.

"Indeed, May 11, 1946 will be etched in history, the founding of Umno served as a platform which fought for the rights, fate and future of the Malays.

"For more than six decades, Umno moved with confidence, Umno moves in tandem with the people's hopes and aspirations. Umno moves with loyalty and wisdom," he added.

He also called on Umno members to give their loyalty and have confidence in the leadership of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, who is also party president, to ensure Umno

continued to be relevant and have a place in the people's hearts.
