

China Vows To Strengthen Cooperation With Malaysia In Combating Transnational Crimes

BEIJING, May 12 (Bernama) -- China has pledged to enhance cooperation with Malaysia in combating transnational crimes.

Minister of Public Security Meng Jianzhu said in a statement that Malaysia and China had built up good relations in law enforcement cooperation.

He urged the two sides to further strengthen cooperation in fighting transnational crimes, especially telecommunications fraud, exit and entry administration, and anti-terrorism.

The statement was issued by China's Ministry of Public Security after Vice Minister of Public Security Meng Hongwei met with visiting Malaysian Deputy Home Minister Datuk Lee Chee Leong here on Friday.

Lee is on a four-day visit to China at the invitation of the Chinese Government aimed at further strengthening cooperation in security matters.
