

Discard Acts Of Sabotage, Dr M Tells Umno Leaders

JITRA, May 20 (Bernama) -- Former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad today reiterated his advice for Umno leaders to discard self-interest and acts of sabotage to ensure a Barisan Nasional (BN) victory in the next general election.

The former Umno president said victory for the party would mean a continuation of BN administration in the country although some leaders would have to give way to others.

"The defeat of Umno would be akin to the Malays losing power in their own country. We cannot afford to be disunited. It is important for us to pool our resources.

"I am convinced that we can win if we can discard acts of sabotage," he said in his address at a meeting with Umno leaders from Kedah at Dewan Wawasan, here.

Dr Mahathir advised all party members to support the selected electoral candidates, even those "parachuted" (brought from elsewhere) to a constituency by the leadership.

He said he felt that the right time for the next general election was after Aidilfitri in August.
