

**Najib Joins Million Youth Rally Participants In Dikir Seribu**

PUTRAJAYA, May 26 (Bernama) -- The atmosphere at the Information Communications and Culture Ministry (KPKK) compound here was one of merriment as Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak and wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor joined the 'Dikir Seribu' presentation by participants of the Million Youth Rally.

Clapping their hands in rhythm were Cabinet ministers Datuk Seri Dr Rais Yatim, Datuk Seri Shabery Cheek, Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Tun Hussein, Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, Datuk Seri Mohd Shafie Apdal, Tan Sri Dr Koh Tsu Koon, and MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Chua Soi Lek.

Najib accompanied by Hishammuddin then launched the Home Ministry's 'Skuad Muda' which was set up especially to plan various activities for youths and instill the spirit of patriotism.

The PM proceeded with a walkabout around the exhibition booths and food stalls while mingling with the crowd.

Later he watched a mock kidnap rescue operation presented by a Malaysian Armed Forces' special team.

Earlier, Najib accompanied by Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri G.Palanivel, who is also MIC president arrived at Little India Street to reveberating bhanga music and lit the Kuttvilaku, an oil lamp used by the Indian community to launch cultural events.

The PM and his wife then headed to the Chinese Youth Cultural Village where he was greeted on arrival by a lion dance during which he also obligingly beat the Chinese 24 season drum as a gesture.
