

BN May Have Special Election Manifesto For Kedah

ALOR SETAR, June 10 (Bernama) -- The Barisan Nasional (BN) is considering having an additional manifesto, solely for Kedah, for the next general election to highlight what the coalition would do if it wins back the state from Pakatan Rakyat, State BN chairman Datuk Ahmad Bashah Md Hanipah said here.

He said the state BN would discuss with the BN headquarters to have a special manifesto for Kedah besides the coalition's national manifesto.

"The (Kedah) manifesto would encompass our promises which will be fulfilled if we win back Kedah. They will not be empty promises," he told reporters after chairing a meeting of the Kedah Umno Liaison Committee last night.

Ahmad Bashah, who is also chairman of the committee, said the visit of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak to Kulim last Friday as part of the "Promises Fulfilled" tour had enabled the people to know the promises which the BN had fulfilled.

He advised members of Umno and the other BN component parties not to worry to much about the BN's defeat in the state in the 2008 general election.
