

PCM To Contest In Penang In Next General Election

BUKIT MERTA JAM, June 18 (Bernama) -- Parti Cinta Malaysia (PCM) announced it will contest two parliamentary and more than 10 state seats in Penang in the next general election.

PCM vice-president Huan Cheng Guan named the parliamentary seats as Batu Kawan and Bagan and some of the state seats as Machang Bubok, Bukit Tengah, Perai, Bagan Dalam and Bagan Jermal.

"I will contest the Batu Kawan parliamentary and Machang Bubok state seats," he told a news conference at the PCM Machang Bubok office, here.
