

20 Pakatan Rakyat Members Return To UMNO

DENGKIL, 20 June (Bernama) - Twenty PAS and PKR members from Kampung Dato Abu Bakar Baginda in Dengkil returned to UMNO after losing faith in the opposition coalition, Pakatan Rakyat.

Former PAS member, Akhiah Samidin, 57, said Pakatan Rakyat leaders made empty promises to deceive the voters during the 12th General Election but did not fulfill any of them for the villagers.
