

**Tan Mohd Aminuddin Worked Hard For Pahang - Najib
Bernama

KUALA LUMPUR, June 20 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak described Pahang senior executive council member Datuk Tan Mohd Aminuddin Ishak, who died Tuesday, as someone who worked hard to develop Pahang and especially the Chenor state constituency.

Having known Tan Mohd Aminuddin personally for a long time, Najib, who is also Umno president, said his contributions to the government and party were very much appreciated.

"My family and I extend our condolences to his family. I hope they will be strong and patient in this difficult time," he said in a statement to Bernama.

The 64-year-old state exco member died at 9am after almost two weeks in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) at Sultan Haji Ahmad Shah Hospital, Temerloh.

He was warded on June 8 for diarrhoea and vomiting before he was transferred to the ICU following other complications including heart problems and diabetes.
