

Agong Confers Bravery Awards On 205 PDRM Officers And Members

KUALA LUMPUR, June 21 (Bernama) -- Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah today conferred bravery awards on 205 officers and members of the Royal Malaysian Police (PDRM) in conjunction with the 205th Police Day celebration.

Raja Permaisuri Agong Tuanku Hajah Haminah was also present at the investiture ceremony held at Istana Negara, here.

Internal Security and Public Order director Datuk Salleh Mat Rasid and PDRM Logistics Department director Datuk Zulkifli Abdullah who led the list of recipients, were conferred the Darjah Panglima Gagah Pasukan Polis (PGPP).

Twenty-four officers received the Darjah Panglima Setia Pasukan Polis (PSPP), including federal Commercial Crime CID deputy director Datuk Tajudin Md Isa, Special Operations Force deputy chief Datuk Ayob Khan Mydin Pitchay and Perlis police chief Zull Aznam Haron.

Also present at the ceremony were Deputy Home Ministers Datuk Abu Seman Yusop and Datuk Lee Chee Leong, and Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Ismail Omar.

This ceremony was the second after a similar one held last Tuesday with 126 recipients.
