

**Mubarak Urges Generasi Y Not To Experiment On 13th GE**

KUALA LUMPUR, June 23 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Council of Former Elected Representatives (Mubarak) hopes that the generation Y today will not experiment on the country's future by giving an opportunity to the opposition to win the 13th general election.

As such, its president Tan Sri Abdul Aziz Rahman called on the young generation to look at what was happening in the states ruled by the opposition because they had demonstrated their inability to rule.
