

**Agong Presents Instruments Of Appointment To Seven Malaysian Envoys**

KUALA LUMPUR, June 25 (Bernama) -- Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah today presented the instruments of appointment to four Malaysian ambassadors and three high commissioners at Istana Negara here.

The ambassadors are Datuk Nik Mustafa Kamal Nik Ahmad who has been assigned to Romania, Datuk Jamaluddin Sabeh to Poland, Datuk Ahmad Anwar Adnan to the United Arab Emirates and Mohd Zulkephli Mohd Noor to Turkmenistan.

The high commissioners are Rosmidah Zahid (New Zealand), Dr Hasrul Sani Mujtabar (Pakistan) and Norlin Othman (Bangladesh).

A statement from the Foreign Ministry said Nik Mustafa was Malaysia's High Commissioner to Nigeria before his new posting, while Jamaluddin was the High Commissioner to Bangladesh.

Ahmad Anwar was the High Commissioner to Pakistan before this and Zulkephli, secretary of the Special Tasks on North Africa Division at Wisma Putra.
