

Perkasa Urges Singapore To Recall Diplomats Involved In Bersih Rally

KUALA LUMPUR, June 25 (Bernama) -- Pertubuhan Pribumi Perkasa (Perkasa), a Malay right wing movement, today staged a peaceful demonstration to hand over a memorandum urging the Singapore High Commission to recall three of its diplomats for their alleged participation in the Bersih 3.0 rally in the Federal capital on April 28.

The 30-minute demonstration in front of the temporary Singapore High Commission office in Jalan Tun Razak, here, which began at 1.30pm, was led Perkasa president, Datuk Ibrahim Ali.

Ibrahim said the one-page memorandum was given to First Secretary Tan Chee King and First Secretary (Political) Haris Rusdi Chai at the office's lobby.

The memorandum, he said, supported Malaysia's principle against interference by foreign quarters in the country's internal affairs as it could threaten the good bilateral relations of both countries.

Ibrahim said Singapore needed to apologise to the Malaysian government and people regarding the incident to prevent more negative perceptions in both countries.
