

Raja Permaisuri Agong Voices Concern Over Increasing Baby Dumping Cases

IPOH, May 29 (Bernama) -- Raja Permaisuri Agong Tuanku Hajah Haminah today expressed concern over increasing cases of baby dumping and of young women duped into acting as drug mules overseas.

The Queen described the situation as saddening because young girls were also involved in the social ills.

"Therefore, an important task for the Girl Guides Association of Malaysia leaders and commissioners is to create awareness among its members and women and girls at large on the importance of looking after themselves and not to be easily duped by irresponsible quarters," she said.

Tuanku Hajah Haminah was speaking at the opening the Conference and Annual General Meeting of the Girl Guides Association of Malaysia (GGAM) 2011/2012, here, Tuesday.

Also present were the prime minister's wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, who is also GGAM president, and Raja Puan Muda Perak Raja Nor Mahani Raja Shahar Shah, who is the association's deputy president and its Perak branch chief.
