

**Over 10 Percent Of Unregistered Johor Voters 50 Years And Above**

JOHOR BA HARU, June 5 (Bernama) -- More than 10 percent of the 429,796 voters who have yet to register in the state seem to be those 50 years and above.

According to the Johor Election Commission (EC) director Rokiah Hanum Ibrahim it was due to apathy about their rights as citizens.

"In fact there are those who only register after retirement and when questioned they respond that they were not aware of the matter and some even say they considered voting as not important," she told reporters here.

As of March 20, the number of Johoreans aged 21 and above eligible to vote was 1, 955, 240 but only 1, 525, 444 were registered, she explained.

It meant that there were still 22 percent voters who have not registered, which was the second highest number after Selangor at 570,858.

Meanwhile, the public may check on their voting registration at the EC's website from June 1 to 30.
