

Videos On Bersih Rally To Be Screened After Review By Independent Probe Panel

KUALA LUMPUR, June 6 (Bernama) -- The video recordings on the Bersih 3.0 rally held in the city on April 28, will be screened to the public after they have been reviewed by the independent panel set up to probe the assembly.

Home Ministry (KDN) secretary-general Datuk Abdul Rahim Mohd Radzi in a statement here said the independent panel should be given enough space and time to evaluate each video clip provided.

He said as such, the ministry would take note of all the opinions and advice given by the panel which would holding a meeting on on Monday (June 11).

Previously, Home Minister Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Tun Hussein had said that KDN would upload the clips on its website by Wednesday (today) so that the people could make their own judgement on what transpired during the rally.

Hishammuddin said the purpose of showing the video recordings obtained from various parties was to enable the people to get the real perspective on events that occurred during the rally.
