KUALA LUMPUR, June 7 (Bernama) -- Raja Permaisuri Agong Tuanku Hajah Haminah visited the Rumah Bakti Datuk Harun (RBDH) in Hulu Kelang, here, in conjunction with the birthday celebration of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong.

The queen was met on arrival by the prime minister's wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, the Deputy Minister of Women, Family and Community Development Datuk Heng Sei Kie and RBDH chairman Datuk Mohd Fahmi Ibrahim.

The queen signed the visitor's book and spent some time at the Ibnu Sina library and RBDH computer lab.

Tuanku Hajah Haminah presented a cheque worth RM15,000, gifts and chatted with 150 orphans from various welfare homes in Hulu Kelang.

Orphans from the Ozanam, Omar Hasfizar and the Community Service Centre for the Deaf performed dances and songs for the queen.

As at April 30 this year, 85 orphans of all races were sheltered at the RBDH, which was established since 1966.
