**GROWING SUPPORT: People can get info on benefits from booths set up by govt agencies at Sunday's carnival**

BANGI: THE Jelajah Janji Ditepati carnival here on Sunday will introduce the people to the government machinery and allow them to see what it has in store for them.

Selangor Barisan Nasional coordinator Datuk Mohd Zin Mohamed said the carnival was estimated to draw 150,000 people and they could see for themselves the transformation programmes that have been implemented by the government.

"More than 110 booths set up by various government agencies at the carnival will provide all the information about the government's benefits for the people.

"This is especially pertinent for the people of Selangor, for whom the Federal Government has done a lot since the last four years."

Zin, who was monitoring the carnival preparations here yesterday, said the people of Selangor had realised that the state could not be separated from the Federal Government.

He said although BN was the opposition in Selangor, the various programmes it organised for the people always received great support and participation.

"Nowadays, when we have programmes in Selangor, the crowd always exceeds our expectation.

"This is especially so with the presence of the prime minister (Datuk Seri Najib Razak), who is like a magnet, attracting people with his genuine and natural approach.

"We were told the previous carnivals had seen tremendous response from the people.

"We hope here will be even more successful. More people in Selangor are approaching BN for help and they have seen how BN's contributions have benefited them."

Zin said the people were welcoming Najib's efforts to benefit them.

"It should be noted that the people of Selangor were among the biggest beneficiaries of Bantuan Rakyat 1Malaysia. A total of 520,000 people have received RM260 million under this programme.

"The state government has not even contributed a fraction of this one single programme, despite their pledges and promises before the 2008 polls."
