

**Negri ruler heads honours list**

*HONOURED: 294 to be conferred awards in conjunction with Terengganu sultan's 50th birthday*

KUALA TERENGGANU: THE Yang DiPertuan Negri Sembilan Tuanku Muhriz Tuanku Munawir heads the list of 294 recipients of awards and medals given out in conjunction with the Sultan of Terengganu Tuanku Mizan Zainal Abidin's 50th birthday today.

Tuanku Muhriz will receive the Darjah Kebesaran Kerabat Terengganu at an investiture ceremony to be held on Sept 30.

The ceremony was postponed due to the fasting month and the venue has yet to be confirmed.

Chief Secretary to the Government Datuk Seri Ali Hamsa is the sole recipient of the Seri Setia Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin (SSMZ) award which carries the title Datuk Seri.

The six recipients of the Datuk Setia Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin Terengganu (DSMZ), which carries the title Datuk, are state finance officer Datuk Abd Razak Ismail; army field commander General Datuk Zulkiple Kassim; Petronas vice-president Datuk Anuar Ahmad; Deputy Solicitor General II Datuk Tun Abd Majid Tun Hamzah; East Coast Economic Region Development council chief executive officer Datuk Jebasingam Issace John; and the late Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia don and historian Prof Datuk Dr Nik Anuar Nik Mahmud.

There are three recipients of the Darjah Kebesaran Mahkota Terengganu Yang Amat Dihormati Seri Paduka Mahkota Terengganu (SPMT) which carries the title Datuk. They are Air Force chief Gen Tan Sri Rodzali Daud; Army commander Gen Tan Sri Zulkifli Mohd Zin; and Petronas president and chief executive officer Tan Sri Shamsul Azhar Abbas.

The 10 recipients of the Datuk Paduka Mahkota Terengganu, which carries the title Datuk, include state police chief Datuk Jamshah Mustapa.

Fourteen will receive the Setia Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin Terengganu (SMZ) award, including state youth and sports committee chairman Rozi Mamat; Petronas senior general manager Riha Azni Abdul Rahman; Universiti Malaysia Terengganu vice-chancellor Prof Dr Yahaya Ibrahim; and Naza TTDI director Mohamad Zahari Harun.

Twenty will get the Ahli Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin Terengganu (AMZ), while the Setia Mahkota Terengganu (SMT) will be bestowed on 15 recipients.
