

Panel on Bersih 3.0 starts hearing

PUTRAJAYA: Former Federal Court judge Tan Sri Nik Hashim Nik Ab Rahman has joined the independent advisory panel on Bersih 3.0.

His inclusion came after ex-Chief Justice of Sabah and Sarawak Tan Sri Steve Shim and Petronas senior general manager Datuk Medan Abdullah opted out.

The panel headed by former Inspector-General of Police Tun Hanif Omar held its first hearing on Monday taking statements from City police chief Deputy Comm Datuk Mohmad Salleh, two journalists from The Sun and another from online news portal The Malaysian Insider.

Hanif said it expected to hold another hearing on Wednesday although he declined to reveal details as to who or how many people would be called.

"There's no limit to the number of people we can call. (We want) anybody who can contribute to giving us the true picture because the Government only wants the true picture," he told reporters.
