

GTP roadshow to view progress and gather feedback

PETALING JAYA: Malaysians who want to view the latest government initiatives to combat crime and on other matters under the Government Transformation Programme can do so in Kuala Lumpur next week.

Pemandu will be holding open day events in Kuala Lumpur on July 24, followed by Kuching on Aug 10 and Kota Kinabalu on Aug 14.

The public can view the new initiatives at the open day and offer feedback under Roadmap 2.0 of the GTP.

Roadmap 2.0 was formulated after Pemandu conducted a series of labs in April and May to identify key issues and new areas of growth.

"Besides continuing with key initiatives identified for the seven NKRA's implemented in 2010, Roadmap 2.0 will also expand on the success of the GTP by focusing on areas which the rakyat clearly seek transformational change," Pemandu said in a statement.

Improving the crime fighting efforts of the police under the Reducing Crime NKRA and addressing curriculum and teaching standards under the Improving Student Outcomes NKRA are among the new initiatives to be implemented.

The public can provide feedback and also attend briefing sessions by Pemandu CEO Datuk Seri Idris Jala and leaders of the seven National Key Result Area (NKRA) labs of the GTP.

There will be an online feedback system where the public can leave feedback and comment on the initiatives of GTP Roadmap 2.0.

The first open day will be held at the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre. The roadshow will continue in Kuching at the Pullman Hotel and conclude in Kota Kinabalu at Sutera Harbour.
