

PM: Reject opposition parties which have negative traits

KUALA LANGAT: The opposition parties have three negative traits - breaking their promises, being ungrateful and telling people not to repay debts, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

He said the people must reject those with such traits.

"The first is that they don't bother to fulfil their promises to the people because they merely make empty political promises," he said when launching the Ku Sihat District Community Programme at the Perkampungan Orang Asli Pulau Carey on Saturday.

He added that ingratitude was another trait practised by the opposition.

Najib said the opposition even called on others not to repay their loans, which was against religious norms.

"Only Barisan Nasional is able to guarantee a future for the country and people," he told the crowd.

Najib also announced RM2.6mil allocation for SK Pulau Carey to enable electricity supply for the school.

He added that over 1,200 Orang Asli households and Indian families in the area would also receive sundry and schooling aid.
