KUALA LUMPUR, July 2 (Bernama) -- Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah today watched the final of the soccer tournament for the Sultan Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah Trophy between the 9th battalion Royal Malay Regiment (RAMD) (Para) and 19th battalion Royal Malay Regiment (RAMD) (Mechanised).
