

King Calls For More Czech Investors To Invest In Malaysia

KUALA LUMPUR, July 5 (Bernama) -- Yang di- Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah today urged Czech Republic investors to take advantage of the investments opportunities in Malaysia especially those offered under the country's Economic Transformation Programme.
