

**BN Assemblymen Questions State Government's Reluctance To Approve Langat 2
Bernama
July 10, 2012**

SHAH ALAM, July 10 (Bernama) -- Batang Kali state assemblyman Datuk Mohd Isa Abu Kassim today lashed out at the PKR-led Selangor government which he described as too resolute in the issue of clean water in the state.

He also questioned their reluctance in approving the Langat 2 Water Treatment Plant project by saying that it would affect the development and the future of the people.

"What is wrong with allowing such a project to enhance clean water supply in the state? he asked while intervening Ng Suee Lim's (DAP-Sekinchan) debate on the 2012 Supplementary Supply Bill during the Selangor State Assembly sitting, here today.

Mohd Isa said the state government's argument that the water tariff would increase due to the water treatment plant project was also invalid, since the state government actually controls 30 per cent of Syarikat Bekalan Air Selangor's share through Kumpulan Darul Ehsan Berhad.

He added that the state government might not really understand the real water issues in the state, whereby the real issue was related to the water source instead of raw water.
