

PM To Attend People's Feast While On Terengganu Visit Friday

KUALA TERENGGANU, July 11 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak will attend a "jamuan rakyat" (people's feast) with some 8,000 to 10,000 local residents at the Kampung Bukit Payong public field, Marang this Friday.

Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Ahmad Said said the feast was organised in conjunction with Najib's one-day visit to Terengganu.

"The state government will give the prime minister a grand welcome and reception in conjunction with his visit," he said after chairing a state executive council meeting, here, Wednesday.

Ahmad said Najib was also scheduled to meet with about 20,000 Rela (People's Volunteer Corps) members from all over Terengganu at the Gong Badak Indoor Stadium, here.

He said the prime minister was expected to arrive at the Sultan Mahmud Airport at 9am on Friday and then head to Dungun in a helicopter to meet with Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM) students there and the local community at Arena Square. Najib will then perform Friday prayers at the Bukit Payong mosque before attending the people's feast at the public field in the village.

Ahmad said the prime minister was expected to return to the federal capital at about 5pm.

He said Najib was scheduled to visit Terengganu again in August to attend a "buka puasa" (breaking-of-fast) function organised by the state government.
