

**Pemandu Denies Wan Azizah's Allegation On Spending Of GTP Fund**

KUALA LUMPUR, July 12 (Bernama) -- Pemandu has rubbished an allegation by Datuk Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail that Putrajaya spent 71 per cent of the Government Transformation Programme (GTP) fund on public relations (PR) exercise to boost public perception towards the police, instead of using it to fight crime.

It described the statement by the PKR president as "totally erroneous and irresponsible".

"Datuk Seri Wan Azizah could have verified her facts before passing false statements to the media which are meant to mislead the Malaysian public on the actual work and progress made under the Reducing Crime NKRA (National Key Result Areas)," said Pemandu's Reducing Crime NKRA director Eugene Teh Yee.

He clarified that Pemandu or Performance Management and Delivery Unit, Prime Minister's Department had only allocated 0.75 per cent or RM 1.8 million of the GTP fund for public awareness and media exercise.

The allocation was used to inform and update the rakyat on initiatives and programmes which had been identified and implemented to combat crime and make Malaysian streets safer and more secure, he told a media briefing here today.
