

**Volunteer Teams To Be Created Under 1Malaysia Community Programme, Says Rais

KUALA KLAWANG, July 13 (Bernama) -- Volunteer teams would be created under the 1Malaysia Community programme (K1M) nationwide to instill a patriotic love for the country and its society, said Information Communication and Culture minister Datuk Seri Dr Rais Yatim.

The volunteers would be trained in courtesy and integrity to propel the 1Malaysia concept to a higher level, he said.

"We have people of various backgrounds under the 1Malaysia Community programme from which we need to create groups prepared to become volunteers. This would be carried out by either the Ministry or Special Affairs Department," said Rais.

"Registration for volunteers would commence on July 17," the Jelebu member of parliament told reporters after launching K1M here Friday.

K1M was previously known as the Bestari Community programme, in line with the Ministry's transformation, which focused on the 1Malaysia concept inspired by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.
