

**I Did Not Read Every Official Document And Attachment, Says Dr Ling
Bernama

KUALA LUMPUR, July 17 (Bernama) -- Former transport minister Tun Dr Ling Liong Sik told the High Court here today that he did not read every official document and their attachments.

He said he normally referred to the memos and letters as the documents and attachments were usually read by his senior officer.

The first defence witness in the Port Klang Free Zone (PKFZ) trial added that he did not understand the Valuation and Property Services Department's (JPPH) valuation.

Examined by defence counsel Wong Kian Kheong as to whether he had ever asked former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad to ignore the JPPH valuation, Dr Ling denied it with a "No".

He also said he had never concealed any facts on the interest rates or cost in relation to the PKFZ project.
