

Dewan Rakyat Adjourns After 12-day Sitting

KUALA LUMPUR, June 28 (Bernama) -- The Dewan Rakyat adjourned sine die Thursday after approving eight bills in a 12-day session which began on June 11.

The eight bills are the Legal Profession (Amendment) Bill 2012, Medical (Amendment) Bill 2012, Supplementary Supply (2012) Bill 2012, Safeguards (Amendment) Bill 2012, Environmental Quality (Amendment) Bill 2012, Minimum Retirement Age Bill 2012, Road Transport (Amendment) Bill 2012 and the Franchise (Amendment) Bill 2012.

The Traditional and Complementary Medicine Bill 2012, which was scheduled to be tabled for second reading during the session, would be tabled at the next session.

Apart from that, the Dewan Rakyat also approved the motion to set up a Special Parliamentary Select Committee on the Lynas Advanced Material Plant.

The next Dewan Rakyat session is scheduled to begin on Sept 24 for 34 days if the Parliament is not dissolved to make way for the 13th general election.
