

Selangor Government Challenged To Change Representative In Syabas

SHAH ALAM, July 21 (Bernama) -- The Gerakan Prihatin Rakyat Selangor (GPRS) has challenged the Parti Keadilan Rakyat-led Selangor government to change their representative in the Syarikat Bekalan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Syabas) management.

This is because its representative is seen to have failed to clarify the actual status of the state's water crisis to the Menteri Besar and state executive council (exco) members.

GPRS chairman, Datuk Sohaimi Shahadan said this was necessary as Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim and his exco still did not understand that the crisis was due to a shortage of treated water because of the high demand and not due to the lack of water in the rivers, mining pools or dams.

"Although the state government has 30 per cent share and a representative in the Syabas management, the Menteri Besar does not understand the system of how treated water is processed.

"Therefore, instead of taking over the management of Syabas, it is better they change their representative in the company," he told reporters at the GPRS office, here, Saturday.
