

PMC Wants Development In Taman Manggis To Benefit The People

GEORGE TOWN, July 23 (Bernama) -- The Penang Malay Congress (PMC) wants the second phase development project to be implemented on a 0.44 hectare plot of land in Taman Manggis on Jalan S.P. Cheliah to benefit the people of Penang especially in terms of economic distribution.

PMC president Rahmad Isahak said whatever development to be implemented must be able to create job opportunities to the people in the state, particularly the Malays.

"If hotels or commercial projects were to be set up in the area, they should be able to provide job opportunities to the local residents," he said at a media conference, here Monday.

The issue on the development in Taman Manggis cropped up following the allegation that the state government was dilly-dallying in implementing the public housing project which was described as insincere in helping the lower-income group.
