

**Sultan Of Kelantan Breaks Fast With Malaysians In Dubai**

KUALA LUMPUR, July 23 (Bernama) -- Sultan of Kelantan, Sultan Muhammad V had attended a breaking of fast event in Dubai last Saturday with some 150 Malaysian nationals currently residing in the United Arab Emirates (UAE).
