

Federal Government Should Be Firm On Langat 2 Project – GPRS

KUALA LUMPUR, July 24 (Bernama) -- The Gerakan Prihatin Rakyat Selangor (GPRS) and 20 other non-governmental organisations (NGO) hope that the federal government will be firm and proceed with the Langat 2 Water Treatment Plant Project.

GPRS chairman Datuk Sohaimi Shahadan said the construction of the Langat 2 plant should proceed immediately as the project was already half completed.

"We do not want the project to be abandoned and become a white elephant as the project is very important to the people especially in the Klang Valley so that they do not have to face a water crisis in future," he told reporters after a meeting with the management of Syarikat Bekalan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Syabas) here today.

He said GPRS would be distributing 500,000 leaflets throughout Selangor to explain to the people on the real issue of Langat 2 plant.

The Langat 2 Water Treatment Plant is part of raw water channelling project from Pahang to Selangor, Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya. However, the project could not proceed without the agreement of the Selangor government.
