

Crimes Against Children And Women Among GTP Second Phase Agenda, Says Hishammuddin

KUALA LUMPUR, July 25 (Bernama) -- The issue of crimes against children and women would be among the main agenda of the Government Transformation Programme (GTP), Phase Two, annual report, Home Minister Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Tun Hussein emphasised.

He said the matter was discussed at a Cabinet meeting Wednesday, with emphasis on children and women to reduce crime rates, under the National Key Results Area.

"The children and women issue needs a different approach under the GTP now. The National Registration Department and Women, Family and Community Development Ministry will be involved this time," he told reporters after a visit to the Chow Kit Children's Activity Centre, here.

He added that members of several volunteer programmes such as 1Malaysia Youth For You (iM4U), the Home Ministry's Young Squad and related non-governmental organisations would be roped in to help with the Second Phase of the GTP.

On a separate development, he said the Cabinet had today approved the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on human trafficking between Malaysia and China, next week.
