

**Differences Between PAS And DAP Shows That Opposition Incapable Of Administering Country - Khairy**

KUALA LUMPUR, July 25 (Bernama) -- Barisan Nasional (BN) Youth chairman Khairy Jamaluddin describes the differences between PAS and the DAP in the opposition pact as a sign of their inability to administer the country if they were to get the opportunity.

He said that basic issues such as those concerning the constitution, which should not have become a problem, was seen to be still a contention among the two parties.

"This is a reminder to the voters that even on fundamental issues, there is still no agreement between them (PAS and DAP), and this can be detrimental to the country if they are given an opportunity to rule," he told reporters after a breaking of fast function, here Tuesday night.

He was commenting on the latest polemic between PAS and the DAP which saw the Central PAS Youth head, Nasruddin Hassan making a statement on the willingness of Karpal Singh to compromise on the 'hudud' law which was denied by the DAP chairman.

On the decision of the High Court today which quashed the order by the Home Minister that declared Bersih 2.0 as an illegal organisation, Khairy said the decision proved that the country's judicial system was independent.
