

Selangor Sultan Urges Muslims To Forget Political Ideologies And Unite

PETALING JAYA, July 26 (Bernama) -- Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah of Selangor urged Muslims in the state to forget their political ideologies and instead unite in the spirit of strong brotherhood in conjunction with the holy month of Ramadan.

He said Muslims should fully focus on their religious obligations and strengthen unity among them so that Islam was held in high regard and respected by people of other faiths.

He stressed that good deeds was called for by Islam so that the faithful could receive Allah's blessings here and in the hereafter.

At the function, he also handed over Aidilfitri aid contributions to 230 needy people, 125 converts and 136 orphans.
