

**Muhyiddin Visits Indah Permai Ramadan Bazaar**

KOTA KINABALU, July 28 (Bernama) -- The Indah Permai Ramadan Bazaar in Sepanggar, near here, received a friendly visit from Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin upon his arrival from Kuala Lumpur.

Muhyiddin, who was accompanied by Sabah Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman, arrived at the bazaar at 4pm and made his way around 176 stalls selling fares for the breaking of fast.

Also present were his wife Puan Sri Noorainee Abdul Rahman, Musa's wife Datin Seri Faridah Tussin and Sabah Resource Development and Information Technology Assistant Minister Datuk Jainab Ahmad Ayid, who is also Karambunai assemblyman.

More than 500 people were busy buying food at the bazaar when Muhyiddin toured the premises.

The Deputy Prime Minister will later break fast with the people at the Jamek Mosque in Kampung Likas and officiate its Knowledge Corner, as well as present tithes to senior citizens, single mothers and converts.

At the ceremony, keys will be presented to home owners under the People's Housing Project and contributions worth RM70,000 will be handed to the Jamek Mosque by several corporate personalities.

Muhyiddin, who is on a series of visits in conjunction with Ramadan, will also represent Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak in distributing zam-zam water and dates to mosque committee members before returning to the nation's capital.
