

**Najib Expected To Visit Kelantan During Ramadan, Says Mustapa

KOTA BAHARU, July 29 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak is expected to make a one-day visit to Kelantan during the ongoing Ramadan fasting month, Kelantan Umno Liaison Committee chairman Datuk Mustapa Mohamed said today.

He said the prime minister was expected to meet the people in Bachok and Ketereh.

However, the date and itinerary of the visit had yet to be finalised, he told reporters after a meeting with a Kelantan Umno think tank, here.

Mustapa, who is international trade and industry minister, said the visit of Najib, who is Umno president and Barisan Nasional chairman, would motivate Kelantan Umno leaders and members to work harder to face the next general election.

He also said that Kelantan Umno had initiated programmes, among them breaking-of-fast events, to get closer to the state's voters living elsewhere, including in the Klang Valley.

"We are convincing them that Kelantan Umno has a high level of commitment to serve the people transform the situation in the state for the better," he said.

The transformation encompassed providing better infrastructure, raising income levels, reducing poverty and increasing job opportunities, he added.
