

**Najib's Visit The Best Raya Gift**

SIK, July 29 (Bernama) -- A Kampung Teloi Tua resident here has described Datuk Seri Mohd Najib Tun Razak's visit to her house as the best hari raya gift for her family.

Kamaliah Ahmad, 50, a single mother, who received help under the Kampung Sejahtera Inspirasi Harmoni Felda (Kasih Felda or Caring Felda) programme, was very excited when the prime minister dropped by at her house during his visit to the Sik District.

"I am very happy, deeply moved and encouraged by the prime minister's visit. I usually watched Datuk Seri on television, but today he came to my house. And it was the best raya gift for my family," she said when met at her home here.

Kamaliah lives in the house, which belonged to her foster mother, with five children and four grandchildren for the past 28 years at no charge.

"I make 'cucur' (fry) for a living and earn about RM500 a month. I could not afford to repair the house. I thanked Felda for repairing the house under the Kasih Felda programme even though I am not a Felda settler," she said.

Meanwhile Felda Foundation chief executive Dr Emel Faizal Mokhtar said recipients of Kasih Felda aid from outside Felda schemes were chosen by village heads, village development and security committees and elected representatives.

"Felda has allocated RM20 million to repair 4,000 homes outside Felda schemes under the first phase of the programme," he said, adding that RM5,000 would be spent for each house for basic repairs such as replacing damaged roofs and walls.
