

Federal Government Approves Allocations For 4 Tamil Schools To Build New Buildings

PADANG SERAI, July 30 (Bernama) -- Four more Tamil primary vernacular schools (SRJK(T)) in Kedah will receive allocations from the federal government to build additional buildings, purchase equipment as well as renovation works involving RM7.421 million.

Kedah MIC Chairman S. Ananthan said among the schools involved were SRJK(T) Ladang Victoria, Padang Serai which would receive a new three-storey block worth RM4 million and SRJK(T) Ladang Bukit Mertajam, Karangan which will get an additional building with equipment worth RM2.521

"SRJK(T) Ladang Sungai Dingin, Mahang, will get a replacement building worth RM500,000 and SRJK(T) Sungai Batu, Merbok, will receive RM400,000 for roof works, repairing of toilets and electrical wiring works," he told Bernama after handing out contributions from the central MIC to four private kindergartens in the Lunas area here, Monday.

Each kindergarten received between RM1,800 and RM2,400 contributed by MIC president Datuk Seri G.Palanivel for the upgrading of facilities in the kindergartens.

Ananthan said works to demolish old buildings in SRJK(T) Ladang Victoria was already being carried out to make way for new ones.
