

Raise Doubts On Electoral Roll With Election Commission

PUTRAJAYA, July 30 (Bernama) -- The Election Commission (EC) has urged certain quarters not to cast aspersion on the electoral roll based on their assumptions without checking with the commission first.

They should not make baseless accusations based on their own findings, instead they should provide evidence to enable the EC to check the data with the National Registration Department (JPN), said EC in a statement.

In a related development, the EC refuted a statement by Selangor PAS election department secretary Wan Mohamad Ghazali Mahmood that a voter named Jarmiah Abu Talib could vote twice as she held two MyKads.

Describing the statement as baseless, the EC said they were two different persons who have different old identity card numbers and different MyKad numbers -- 49032-08-5370 and 470321-08-5540.

It said EC officers had visited both of them and found that they were sisters of different ages, but shared the same name.
