

**Campaign Materials Must Have Details Of Printers And Political Parties – EC

KUCHING, Aug 1(Bernama) - Candidates contesting 13th general election must comply with Election Commission (EC) regulations that campaign materials have the names and addresses of printers and political parties to prevent corruption.

EC chairman Tan Sri Abdul Aziz Mohd Yusof said the conditions which cover all campaign materials are to help the police or Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) check with the printers who paid for the bills.

"If something is wrong with the posters, we know who are responsible for them," he told reporters after a meeting with political party leaders and the media here on Wednesday.

Abdul Aziz said under subsection 11 (1) (c) Election Offences Act 1954, the EC also have the power to remove the campaign materials.

Debate in Dewan Rakyat and Dewan Negara during amendment to the act also mentioned that corruption could happen if the campaign materials were paid by certain people.
